

Volunteer Role Title: Sports Activity Helper

Aim of volunteering role:

To support "Your Space", in providing appropriate opportunities for development and fun for children and young people diagnosed with an Autism Spectrum Condition.

Tasks:

- 1. Recognise and support individuals in areas designated by the Activity Leader
- 2. To take part in the various activities as designated by Activity leader/ coordinator.
- 3. Help to present "Your Space" information to parents and carers and assist in the setting up and closing down of the sessions.
- 4. To encourage young people's participation and engagement in activities.
- 5. To encourage young people's interaction and relationship building with peers.
- 6. To help keep our young people safe and happy.

Targets:

- 1. to understand the nature of Autism and the difficulties that individuals may have.
- 2. to aid individuals in their enjoyment and communication with others.

Time:

Flexible time commitment, ideally volunteers should be available for one day/ evening per month (or up to two days per holiday week) in order for a workable rota to be implemented and for the children and young people to recognise and build positive relationships with those assisting them.

Transport needed:

Volunteers do not require own transport during volunteering hours

Skills required:

- 1. Interest in and commitment to the complex needs of children and young people with an A.S.C.
- 2. Interest in and ability to work with children on activities offered (Sports, music, dance, creative arts and free play).
- 3. A good communicator; a sense of humour; flexibility and a team player.

Benefits offered:

- 1. The chance to be part of a new and exciting project and help with its growth
- 2. On the job training and chance to undergo further mandatory training and specific autism courses.
- 3. Travel expenses paid.
- 4. Insurance cover.
- 5. Chance to undertake fund-raising initiatives.
