Your Space is an autism charity based in Llay Park Resource Centre, Wrexham. We offer a range of activities for children and young adults with autism and also support the family and wider community. Our friendly team of staff are passionate about the work we do and we value the wellbeing of all staff, volunteers and family members.

The Sit-in Worker will be responsible for travelling (using their own transport – expenses will be reimbursed) to family homes to look after a child with an Autistic Spectrum Condition aged 5 years+ (and sibling(s)).

A full risk assessment will be conducted prior to any booking being made.

The Sit-in Worker will manage their own working hours, using booking software to communicate their availability so that families can pre-book appointments.

During the school term, we expect bookings to be made after school hours and over the weekend. During school holidays, bookings will be made during the day and evening, weekdays and weekends. Appointment durations will vary between 2 – 4 hours long.

This role will be fully supported by our dedicated and experienced team and the Sit-in Worker will receive full training. This role offers valuable work experience, job satisfaction and working hours flexibility.

We are looking for someone who has lived or worked with someone with autism and is passionate about promoting the wellbeing of others. The ability to speak Welsh is also desirable.
